

Falmouth Conservation Commission Minutes of November 7, 2016

Meeting convened at 6:30 p.m.

Pesticide Restriction Ordinance

Susan opened the subject of an ordinance on pesticide restriction. Fred Dillon (South Portland water quality staff member) spoke from a professional perspective about South Portland's experience in developing a pesticide restriction ordinance. He also shared his experience doing the same in Portland but from the perspective of a resident. Dillon recommended broad community input in the development of an ordinance.

Andy Jones of the Toxic Action Center gave some background and historical information on pesticide usage, industry standards, and best practices. Jones spoke of increased use of pesticides on lawns. He sees this as the most serious issue involving issues of human health, animal health, and environmental health.

Following the departure of the guests, members discussed how to proceed. Caleb recommended the dog ordinance process as a model. It included on-going opportunity for community input.

The next meeting of the FCC will be on November 28 at 4:00 p.m. to discuss the pesticide ordinance development process. Susan will draw up a possible process outline.
