Items & Updates:

Other quick updates from Kimberly—

Streetlight LED project going well! Cobra heads are almost done and the crews are now working on the post-top fixtures. Installation should be complete by the end of month.

- **New construction requirements (LEED) for Falmouth Center buildings**
