



TOWN OF FALMOUTH OFFERS FOOD SCRAP DROP-OFF PROGRAM

Falmouth residents visiting the transfer station facility on Woods Road can now compost their food scraps free of charge!

Simply bring your food scraps in a separate bucket or container during your regular trip to the transfer station and deposit your food scraps into the designated compost totes.

The food waste will be collected by a local composting company, We Compost It! and converted to compost. Participants will receive free compost at the transfer station for participating.

It is estimated that 25%-33% of residential trash is food waste that is compostable. Composting can reduce your trash bag costs and also increase overall recycling rates.
