Councilor's Farber and Mahoney were present at the meeting.

The Appointment Committee met at 5:30 PM in the Council Chambers in the Town Hall. following Falmouth citizens were informally interviewed and asked to tell a little about themselves. The applicants for the new adhoc committee were asked what their vision and challenges were for Route 100 was. The following were interviewed, Gerald & Tannia Bell-Route 100, Paul Burlin – Conservation Commission, Dave Libby – Route 100, Lucas Walker- Route 100, Lori Legere- Route 100, Jahnna Steindl- Route 100 & FEIC, Rebecca Grover- Route 100.

Jahnna Steindl decided she would like to withdraw her application for the ad-hoc Route 100 Committee and be considered for the Falmouth Economic Improvement Committee.

Chair Farber explained to the Gerald and Tannia Bell that they needed to decide which one of them would like to be considered for the new ad-hoc Route 100 Committee, they both could not fill the same seat. It was decided Gerald would be the one to be considered. Councilor Farber explained to all of the applicants the expected time frame for appointments. The goal is to have recommendations to the Council at the end of April or the beginning of May. The Route 100 Committee would not be meeting until after the new Councilors are elected and the Council Liaison is picked on June 18. The Falmouth Economic Improvement Committee had one vacancy and there were three candidates.

Chair Farber asked Ellen Planer to get in touch with the co-chairs of the Conservation Commission and have them contact Paul Burlin, and to also give Jahnna Steindl's contact information to the chair of FEIC and ask them to get in touch with her to discuss the committee.
