FALMOUTH QUESTION 1 June 11 ballot

Voters will decide on June 11 whether or not to approve infrastructure improvements in Route One's business district.

They include:

- putting utility lines underground,
- widening sidewalks,
- adding landscaped medians to improve safety for vehicles and pedestrians,
- lining the street with trees and streetlights, and
- retrofitting stormwater systems to reduce pollution.


Intended to encourage economic development and broaden the tax base, the project will cost \$11.7 million and be paid with taxes set aside from property owners in the business district. The plan does not call for the use of any other property taxes.
