# Update on Pesticide Restriction Ordinance:

**Invasive Species:** Nancy reported that the Town will incorporate monies for invasive species removal into the annual budget.

Nancy will email to members the town's position statement regarding the use of herbicides to control invasives.

Nancy reported on a new invasive in the town, The Tree of Heaven.

**LPAC:** Sarah reported that the final draft of the Greening of Falmouth 2.0 has been submitted to the Town Council.

**Tree City:** Rich reviewed the requirements for achieving Tree City status and agreed to draft a tree care ordinance.

**Highland Lake Leadership Team:** Nancy updated the Commission on collaborative work between Falmouth and Windham to determine the cause of algae growth.
