

**Town Council Finance Sub-committee Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order @ 5:11PM

- The Minutes of October 26, 2015 were approved.
- There were no changes to the Committee Schedule.
- Lien and Foreclosure Report.
  - a. Ellen Planer presented the Lien and Foreclosure Report. There were 13 properties on the list with one new addition from last year's report.
  - b. There was much discussion about the approach that should be taken with these properties. It was decided that auction sales on vacant properties would be the best approach.
    - i. The committee recommended that 6 properties should be presented to the council for possible action.
- Investment Plan Update
  - a. Nathan presented the investment results reflecting the additional \$4.1 million investment and the increased interest revenue of \$39K.
    - i. There was a group discussion about how much more we should invest based on the available fund analysis. It was recommended that we should look at investing another \$2-3 million.
- TIF Update
  - a. Nathan presented a summary of the current status of our 4 TIF Districts.
    - i. The group discussed details of each of the TIFs.
- Route 100 Project Update
  - a. Nathan presented the current status of the Route 100 project including cost estimates and scope of work. Nathan then presented the financing plan showing a \$4 million contribution from Maine DOT and a \$6.5 million bond issue.
    - i. There were questions about whether sewer improvements should be included in the project, project gaps and the extent of the sidewalk and pedestrian lighting contained in the plan.
- Adjourn
  - a. Councilor Hemphill moved to adjourn the meeting and Councilor Farber seconded. The meeting adjourned at 6:30PM.
