Falmouth Fire-EMS Offers Fire Safety Dialogue for Businesses

Local business owners to share real-life experiences

FALMOUTH, Maine—Falmouth Fire-EMS has joined with local Falmouth business owners to offer a Fire Safety Dialogue specifically for businesses. The event will be held from 9:00-10:30am on Thursday, September 26 at the Central Fire Station on Bucknam Road. According to Chief Howard Rice, business owners, property managers, property owners, and employees responsible for maintenance and/or emergency response will benefit from listening to a panel of their peers discuss their own experiences with fire safety in their place of business.
