Falmouth Fire-EMS Awards Annual Scholarship

Today Falmouth Fire-EMS awarded a \$1,000 scholarship to Isabella Roy, a 2020 graduate of Falmouth High School. Isabella is the first ever recipient of the scholarship, created to recognize graduating high school seniors living in the Falmouth community who plan to continue their post-secondary education in the field of firefighting, emergency medical services, nursing, or a related field. Isabella plans on studying nursing at the University of New England this fall. Chief Howard Rice, Jr. presented Isabella the award and wished her the best of luck in her journey into nursing, especially in these ever-changing times of COVID-19. In presenting the award Chief Rice stated: "It is great to see another Falmouth High School graduate entering the medical profession. It will be challenging yet rewarding." Several members of the on-duty crew at the station attended the presentation wearing face coverings and wished Isabella well in her intended career path.
