Homestead Farms

There will be a public hearing prior to any development. There will also be an impact study conducted to determine effect on schools of such a large scale development.

Parks Division:

Some of the fields at community park will receive slice aeration this fall, which should help with weed control and lawn growth.

Next month the division will prepare for snow.

On Memorial Day 2018, there will be an Old Home Day as part of the Tercentennial celebration, which will be held at Community Park. The celebration will include historical tours (by bus or self-guided), a travelogue, and a volksmarch.
