- Motion to adopt the September minutes was approved
- Lucky summarized the October meeting, which was the semi-annual parks tour
 of the west side of town

 - Preparations for Winter Operations (plows, sanders, etc.) have begun as well as seasonal maintenance for equipment storage is underway.
- December 6, and 7th: A Very Merry Falmouth will take place again. The department will be assisting throughout the weekend which is "kicked-off" at the Tree Lighting on Thursday, December 5th 5:30-6:30pm at Village Park.
- The Winter/Spring brochure is being finished, with distribution and registration is scheduled to begin on December 10.
- Lucky is putting the finishing touches on the Senior newsletter for Dec/Jan.
- FPD did a safety and security assessment of the building
 - Overall, the assessment was good. The Town has been conducting assessments of all Town facilities and will be implementing new policies and procedures in the coming months along with training for all permanent employees.
- Lucky presented the NRPA Agency Performance Review benchmarks as they relate to the Town of Falmouth.
