

- All rear lines of the shoreland zone are 250 ft. from the normal high water line or upland edge of designated wetland.
 For spatial requirements and performance standars, see the Falmouth Zoning and Site Plan Review Ordinance, Section 7.
- The SP district is 100 ft. from the normal high water line of any designated stream or brook.
 The provisions of shoreland zoning apply in addition to all other zoning requirements of the underlying zoning district.
- The boundaries shown on this map are illustrative of the general location of shoreland zoning districts boundaries. Precise locations must be field determined and are subject to Planning Board interpretation.
