Item 2 – Review Zoning Maps/General Discussion

The committee reviewed current zoning maps and discussed the five uses of retail marijuana and where they would be permitted in town. Some general questions were:

- 1. Is growing marijuana considered agriculture?
- 2. With no action taken, could someone use the existing definition of home occupation to sell marijuana brownies? Is that a legit home occupation?
- 3. Using Backyard Farms (Madison) as an example....is there any size limitation on the structure/footprint of a greenhouse in the Farm/Forest zone?
- 4. Regarding marijuana farms... where would they be allowed and what do we want them to look like?
- 5. Licensing questions...licensed at the state only or can we require a local license?
- 6. What is the definition of a Research Facility? Is there a difference between a lab and a research facility? Is there a definition of laboratory?

Amy will follow up with Community Development to obtain answers to the questions. The state licensing discussion will be saved for Representative Pierce. The committee agreed that a representative from Community Development should come to a future meeting (preferably October 4).

Amy provided a scheduling update for the September 19 meeting. Our guest speaker has a potential conflict so there was discussion about adding a September 27 meeting as well as one on October 4.
