We were able to provide free trash bags to residents for neighborhood cleanup efforts, and there will be a webinar coming soon on forestry in Falmouth. Three pine trees have also been planted for Earth Day/Arbor Day/Bicentennial celebration on Route 1/Route 88 intersections.
