

So, what about traffic?

We promise to keep traffic disruptions to an absolute minimum.

During daylight hours, two-way traffic will be maintained (*there may be rare occasions when one-way traffic is required for a few minutes*) and flag crews will be on hand to guide you. Access to Route One businesses will ALWAYS be maintained.

Occasional night work can be expected. During night operations, some alternating one-way traffic will be required. Flaggers will be on hand to assist.

Route One is undergoing major improvements between Route 88 and Bucknam Road, including:

- Burying most utilities—electrical, phone/data, TV
- NEW natural gas service—cheaper and greener
- Better turning lanes and median islands
- Improved sidewalks and crosswalks
- Improved traffic lights and sequencing
- Better roadway and pedestrian lighting
- Beautiful new landscaping

This work will occur during the summer, fall and early winter of 2014. In early summer of 2015, the project will be completed when Route One is re-paved.
