Near completion and completed items include: Consistent Agenda Posting, Committee Updates to Council, Public Notice for BZA/Proposals, Comprehensive Communications Strategy, Bike Ped Plan, Financial Targets for School and Town Budgets, Open Space Plan Implementation, Pesticide and Fertilizer Regulation, Solar Farm Development, Blackstrap Road Construction Plan, Highland Lake Watershed Management Plan, Review Intersection of Foreside Road and Johnson Road, Tidewater Master Plan Extension, Route 1 North Preliminary Engineering, Newsletter/Community Events Calendar, Opioid Misuse Strategy (ongoing), Curbside Automated Waste/Recycling Collection (2 out of 3 items), and River Point Archaeological Site National Register of Historic Places.

The items assigned to the Comprehensive Plan Update New Committee are essentially on hold as the visioning process will take place first and has not yet begun.

The Council briefly discussed the status of the proposed mooring fee increase.

The Council expressed support for increasing the priority of the Falmouth Road Footbridge item.

The Council briefly discussed the Curbside Automated Waste/Recycling Collection item.

The Council discussed adding the items, Library Charging Stations MOU and Document Retention Program.
