ORDER NO 148-2017

AD-HOC TOWN MARIJUANA COMMITTEE

BE IT HEREBY ORDERED THIS 22ND DAY OF MAY, 2017, BY THE FALMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL, FALMOUTH MAINE, IN TOWN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED:

To establish an Ad hoc committee of three town councilors which will consist of at least one representative of the Ordinance Committee and one representative of the CDC. All members will be determined by the Council at its organizational meeting June 19, 2017.

Purpose: to make recommendations to the Council regarding zoning amendments, and licensing requirements as needed, related to retail (commercial) marijuana enterprises in Falmouth. Recommendations will be the result of:

- 1) solicitation and consideration of input from the public;
- 2) consultation with the entire Council through public workshops;
- 3) consultation with public safety;
- 4) consideration of impacts on youth;
- 5) consideration of directions taken by neighboring towns;
- 6) consideration of experiences of other states;
- 7) understanding financial implications for the town;
- 8) and other sources of information felt to be valuable to the process.
