REVISIONS TO 2016 FALMOUTH BICYCLE-PEDESTRIAN PLAN

- Whereas,** on May 23, 2016, the Town Council approved a resolution regarding the 2016 Falmouth Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan which stated that the Town Council agrees to use the plan as a reference document in developing its Annual Work Plans, operating and capital improvements budgets, and Tax Increment Financing (TIF) development plans; and
- Whereas,** on July 25, 2016, the Town Council authorized Town staff to seek members for the informal stakeholder group and commence work on the 2016-2018 actions; and
- Whereas,** on October 20, 2016 MaineDOT conducted a meeting to take public comment on proposed rehabilitation of the Lunt Road and Bucknam Road bridges over Interstate 295, a project that may present an ideal opportunity to improve pedestrian and bicycle access on these bridges as well as their approaches; and
- Whereas** formal documentation through a revised plan of the Town's intent for Lunt and Bucknam Roads will clarify the need to ensure safe bicycle and pedestrian improvements are considered on these two roads.
