

## TOWN OF FALMOUTH RESOLUTION

## Expanding the membership of the Long-range Planning Advisory Committee (LPAC)

- **WHEREAS**, in April, 2018 the Town Council, in response to a citizen petition, committed to reviewing the 2016 zoning amendments that allowed for increased density in certain geographical areas of Town called "growth areas"; and
- **WHEREAS**, as part of its 2018-2019 workplan the Council assigned LPAC the task of analyzing growth in the RA district since the 2016 amendment of the ordinance, conducting a public forum to solicit public input on the current status of zoning in RA, and drafting a report to Council with their findings; and
- **WHEREAS,** in the midst of this effort, in December 2018, two of the members of LPAC reached the end of their terms; and
- WHEREAS, in the interest of preserving institutional memory for this complicated project, the Appointments Committee recommended appointing those two members to an expansion of LPAC, called "LPAC+", which recommendation the Council approved in January 2019; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Council wishes to formalize the action taken in January with regards to LPAC's membership.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH ASSEMBLED THIS 11th DAY OF MARCH 2019, THAT:

- 1. To expand the membership of LPAC by 2 members, in accordance with Section 2-71.a of the Town ordinance, in order to complete their work on reviewing growth and density in town.
- 2. To confirm that the appointment of Sam Rudman and Saundra Lipsey to this expanded LPAC, known as LPAC+, are "+" members.
