

2018 Charter Commission Timeline

Updated 5/30/2018

- May 23 Advertise for remaining three members of the Charter Commission.
- June 12 Municipal Election to elect six members to the Charter Commission. The remaining three members must be appointed within 30 days after the election.
- June 18 Town Council organizational meeting. New Appointments Committee is formed.
- June 19-22 Appointments Committee interviews candidates. Date and time to be determined.
- June 25 Appointments Committee makes a recommendation to the Council to appoint three members to the Charter Commission (one member can be a Town Councilor).
- June 26 Town Clerk notifies the Charter Commission members of the date, time and place of the Charter Commission's organizational meeting. At least 7 days' notice is given for the meeting.
- July 16 Charter Commission organizational meeting. A chair, vice-chair, and secretary are elected. The commission files a notice of these elections with the Town Clerk.
- July – September Charter Commission continues to meet. First Public Hearing is held during this time (late August).
- September 24 Public Hearing on Charter Commission final report. Order to approve the Charter Warrant and Ballot.
- November 6 Election – Vote to accept Charter Commission report.
- July 1, 2019 New Charter becomes effective
