

Ad-Hoc Community Park Connector Committee
Proposed October 15, 2014 to the Town Council

There is hereby established an Ad-Hoc Community Park Connector Committee consisting of seven (7) members serving without pay to be appointed by the Town Council.

Purpose/goals/charge:

The Community Park Connector Committee shall:

1. Assist the Town Council, with Town staff support, with the development of a vision and plan for a connection pathway, bridge(s) and/or tunnel between the Falmouth Schools Campus and Community Park.
2. Focus on developing a trail connection to provide a safe, accessible and legal means to walk directly to and from the School Campus and Community Park.
3. Offer recommendations for consideration by the Town Council:
 - Fundraising and possibilities within a Public/Private partnership
 - Community Support
 - Public accessibility and safety, and
 - Implementation strategies.
4. Provide status reports to the Town Council on a regular basis.
5. The Committee shall meet as necessary, with the Chair, or Vice Chair in his/her absence, having the authority to schedule meetings.

Membership: Appointment, term, makeup.

1. The Town Council shall appoint an ad-hoc committee of seven (7) citizens of the town who shall serve without pay.
2. All members shall be voting members.
3. A quorum required to do business shall be four members.
4. The committee should consist of representation from some of the following:
 - Town Council
 - School Board and school community
 - The Falmouth Land Management and Acquisitions Committee (LMAC)
 - Athletic Boosters, e.g., Soccer, Football, Nordic Ski, Cross Country
 - Trail Users, e.g., mountain bicyclists, trail runners
 - Snowmobile Club (Falmouth Sno-Voyageurs)
 - PACPAC
 - Falmouth Land Trust
 - Neighborhood Residents
