Community Wellness Committee Adopted ______ by the Falmouth Town Council

Establishment

There is hereby established a Community Wellness Committee. The Community Wellness Committee shall replace the previous Human Services Committee.

Appointment, terms, officers

- 1. The Town Council shall appoint a committee of up to eleven (11) members who shall serve without pay.
- 2. Of these eleven (11) initial members, three (3) members shall be appointed for one-year terms; four (4) members shall be appointed for two-year terms; and four (4) members shall be appointed for three-year terms, all commencing on January 1, 2020. All appointments thereafter shall be three-year terms. Members shall continue to serve until their successors have been appointed and qualified.
- 3. The committee shall annually choose one (1) of its own members to serve as chairperson and one (1) to serve as vice-chairperson.
- 4. The town council shall appoint a council liaison to this committee.

Meetings, reports

- 1 The committee shall meet as necessary, with the chair, or vice chair in his/her absence, having the authority to schedule meetings.
- 2 All members shall be voting members.
- 3 A quorum will be required to do business shall be a majority of the number of members appointed by the Council.
- 4 The committee shall report to the town council once annually and more frequently at the request of the council.
- 5 The committee shall prepare and submit an annual proposed work plan for review, input and approval from the town council.

Powers and duties

- 1. Determine best strategies and practices to inform and promote wellness for individuals, families, and the community of Falmouth as a whole, such as creating a wellness resource guide and/or creating an annual wellness event;
- 2. Educate and engage the public around available wellness resources, including existing resources (such as the schools, community programs, open space, and area businesses and nonprofits)
- 3. Respond to relevant and current challenges and opportunities that impact our wellbeing as a community;
- 4. Evaluate, develop and continue to implement the Town's annual grant-making program to dispense town funds to area social service agencies.

The majority of the committee shall consist of:

- Falmouth residents
- Falmouth business owners who provide wellness services in Falmouth

The committee may have a representative from the following:

- Falmouth Schools
- Parks and Community Programs
- Public Safety Departments
- Falmouth Memorial Library
