## **ORDER NO 102-2020**

## RENEWAL AND EXTENSION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

- **WHEREAS,** on March 15, 2020 the Governor of the State of Maine declared a civil state of emergency in the State of Maine due to the outbreak of novel coronavirus (COVID-19);
- **WHEREAS**, the Town Council Chairperson declared a civil state of emergency due to COVID-19 in the Town of Falmouth on the same date as this order pursuant to Section 2-507 of the Town of Falmouth's Code of Ordinances;
- **WHEREAS,** the Town Council has the authority to renew and extend a civil state of emergency pursuant to Section 2-508 of the Town of Falmouth's Code of Ordinances;

## BE IT HEREBY ORDERED THIS $27^{\mathrm{TH}}$ DAY OF MARCH 2020, BY THE FALMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL, FALMOUTH MAINE, IN TOWN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED:

To renew the civil state of emergency declared by the Town Council Chairperson on March 27, 2020 after five days has expired on April 1, 2020, and to extend the civil state of emergency in the Town of Falmouth for a period of thirty (30) days until May 1, 2020.
