Ad-Hoc Route 1 North Committee

Adopted September 28, 2015 by the Town Council <u>Proposed revision November 17, 2015</u>

There is hereby established an Ad-Hoc Route 1 North Committee consisting of up to nine (9) members serving without pay to be appointed by the Town Council pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. § 3261.

Purpose/goals/charge:

The Route 1 North Committee shall:

- 1. Assist the Community Development Committee (CDC) and Town staff with the development of a vision and master plan for Route 1 North.
- 2. Focus on an area encompassing Route 1 North from Turnpike Spur to Cumberland line.
- 3. Include in its recommendations considerations regarding:
 - zoning (incl. permitted uses, development intensity, and design/performance standards),
 - o public infrastructure improvements (incl. road, streetscape, utilities), and
 - implementation steps.
- 4. Provide status reports to the CDC on a regular basis.
- 5. The Committee shall meet as necessary, with the Chair, or Vice Chair in his/her absence, having the authority to schedule meetings.
- 6. The Committee shall report back to the Council within one (1) year after its first convenes.

Membership: Appointment, term, makeup.

- The Town Council shall appoint an ad-hoc committee of up to nine (9) <u>memberscitizens of the</u> town who shall serve without pay.
- 2. All members shall be voting members.
- 3. A quorum required to do business shall be majority of the number of members appointed by the Council, but never less than four (4).
- 4. The committee may have representation from some, or all, of the following:
 - Planning Board
 - Falmouth Economic Improvement Committee (FEIC)
 - Long Range Planning Advisory Committee (LPAC)
 - Conservation Commission
 - o Falmouth-Cumberland Community Chamber
 - Area Business Owners/Employees
 - Neighborhood Residents
