# Town of Falmouth, Maine SENIOR TAX ASSISTANCE



### **OVERVIEW**

- The Falmouth Town Council has set aside \$50,000 to be used to provide Property Tax Assistance to low-income seniors
- Assistance award will be based on:
  - One-half of the amount of 2017 property tax paid that exceeds 4% of household income up to \$750 for homeowners
  - One-half of 15% of the amount of 2017 rent paid that exceeds 4% of income up to \$750 for Falmouth renters
- If the total amount awarded to eligible applicants exceeds \$50K then awards will be based on a prorata share of the \$50K

- Born October 15, 1957 or earlier
  - Proof of Age
- Household income <= \$30,000 per year</p>
  - Proof of Income
    - Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ
    - Social Security Statement
    - Income documentation if did not file a return
- Current Falmouth Resident
  - Proof of residency
    - Current utility bill, mortgage statement, rental agreement, property tax bill etc.

### **Income Eligibility Options**

- Household income <= \$40,000 per year</p>
  - Assume 25% Participation
    - Liability = \$62K
    - 81% Funded at \$50K
- Household income <= \$35,000 per year</p>
  - Assume 25% Participation
    - Liability = \$53K
    - 94% Funded at \$50K
- Household income <= \$30,000 per year</p>
  - Assume 25% Participation
    - Liability = \$37K
    - 134% Funded at \$50K
