
#### **Utilities General Notes:**

- 1. The Contractor shall be responsible for notifying Dig-Safe and adhering to all applicable laws.
- 2. The contractor shall also notify any non-dig safe utility members (including Falmouth Public Works and Falmouth Wastewater Dept.'s) through 'OK to dig'.
- 3. Prior to commencement of work, the Contractor, by careful examination, must make themselves familiar with all utilities in the work area, both underground and overhead.
- 4. The locations shown on the Plan are based on the best information available, but the Owner/Engineer does not warrant their accuracy in either horizontal or vertical locations, nor do they warrant that all existing utilities are shown.
- Certain relocation work may be required by existing utilities to allow installation of the work of this Contract.
- 6. As needed, the Contractor shall make arrangements with such utilities for proper on-site coordination of construction.
- 7. During construction, the Contractor shall carefully protect all utilities from damage, and will notify appropriate representatives of utilities when work is to be accomplished in proximity to their facilities.
- 8. The Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damage to existing utilities.
