

ADDENDUM #1 Mast Road Culvert Replacement December 22, 2021

Questions:

- Is there additional milling beyond the limit of work shown on the plans? Or is item #1 intended for removing the pavement inside the limits by means of excavator, not milling?
 Answer: No pavement milling is planned. Pavement removal shall be by stripping the asphalt with and excavator to the limits shown on the plans.
- 2. Is the intention to leave all existing trees in place? If it is deemed a tree needs to be removed, will this be paid for via change order?

Answer: There are two trees identified at the downstream end of the culvert that will need to be removed. These two trees should be considered incidental to the culvert bid item. Any other trees will need to be approved during construction and will be paid via change order. See image below.



3. Is utilizing Brook St & Blackstrap Rd the intended detour for the 1 week of allowable road closure?

Answer: Most likely yes, and Babbidge Road.

4. Is re-striping the road required since there will be an overlay soon after project completion? Answer: No restriping is required. The Town will put TOMS down until the Mast Road is paved.

Clarifications:

1. The quantities for items #7 and #8 were swapped in the original bid form. Please use the revised bid form attached to this addendum. An addendum acknowledgement statement was also added to the bid form.
