

These specifications require the doing of all-necessary, as for, or incidental to the furnishing and delivery of said vehicle and associated equipment. All things not expressly mentioned in these specifications, but involved in carrying out their intent are required by these specifications and the vendor shall perform the same as though we specifically mentioned, described and delineated.

The vehicle and all associated equipment shall be furnished complete and in readiness for use, as required by the terms of these specifications and strict accordance therewith.

The unit and all equipment furnished shall be manufacturer's latest listed and published stock model, which meet all applicable requirements of these specifications. All design, materials and workmanship, shall in every respect, be in accordance with the best current practices in the industry and all materials used shall be new.

Equipment must be completely inspected and serviced by the vendor prior to delivery.

The town reserves the right to negotiate with any bidder; and the Town reserves the right to reject any and all quotes.
