Please complete the below application to be considered for entry into the festival as an exhibiting artist, wellness practitioner, or nonprofit. We will reply within 7 days of receipt of your application.

Insurance: All vendors participating in Falmouth Community Fest are required to provide a certificate of insurance coverage naming the Town of Falmouth as additional insured. Please note that an application does not guarantee participation. A reply will be sent to those receiving booth space within 7 days of application. Payment is due upon acceptance into the festival. Booth Rental Fees:

Artists: Must provide and set up own 10'X10' canopy.
Booth Space=\$75. Paid at time application is accepted.

Wellness Practitioners: Must provide and set up own 10'X10' canopy.
Booth space for single practitioner = \$75.

Nonprofits: Must provide and set up own 10'x10' canopy.
Booth space= Free

* Call if you need financial help with booth rental or insurance. A shared booth or sliding scale may be an option.

Booth rental fees will be returned in the case of cancellation due to inclement weather.
