ROUTE 100 PROJECT - GRAY ROAD CLOSURE
WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 9



Beginning Monday, September 9, Gray Road, between Mountain Road and Eastern Avenue, will be closed to through traffic for one week, 24-hours-a-day, for a culvert installation at a stream crossing.

Residents can still access their properties. Businesses will be open. While some businesses along the Route 100 corridor will be more difficult to access during this road closure, we hope that you will continue to patronize them during this challenging phase of the Route 100 construction project.

Message boards will be located at each end of the primary detour alerting vehicles of the road closure ahead and advising them to use Blackstrap Road. Detour signs will be placed along the primary and secondary detour routes directing vehicles through the proposed detour.
