

Rules for Vendors and Exhibitors

Falmouth Fest & Old Home Days May 26, 2018 10am-4pm

Application acceptance and space assignments are at the discretion of the Festival Organizers. Payment from commercial vendors is due with application.

Vendors and exhibitors whose display varies substantially and/or materially from the description provided to the Organizers on the vendor's application may be ejected at any time without recompense at the discretion of the Festival Organizers.

Vendors and exhibitors must be compliant with all applicable town, state and federal laws at all times.

Booth space and areas immediately in front of and behind vendor/exhibitor space must be clean and free of trash at all times.

Vendors and exhibitors are responsible for clearing all trash from their site and leaving it in a condition as found.

Displays should not extend beyond the assigned area, except where expressly permitted by the Organizers.

Displays must not include illegal material or goods, or promote activities illegal under Maine or Federal law or that pose a substantive risk of injury or death to attendees.

Vendors and exhibitors must be set up prior to 10.00 am and must not take down booths until after 4.00 pm.

Vendors may not drive motorized vehicles into the festival area during the hours of 10.00am to 4.00pm, except with express permission of the Organizers. (This does not apply to emergency vehicles responding to public safety).

Absolutely no consumption of alcoholic beverages or smoking on Festival grounds.

Amplified sound in vendor/exhibitor areas is strictly prohibited.

Sale of live animals is prohibited, with the exception of adoption of pets by licensed shelters and rescues.

Vendors are responsible for carrying General Liability Insurance for their activities. Enclose a certificate of insurance with your completed application.

Vendors using open flames must have permission from both the Organizers and the Town Fire Marshall.

Vendors and exhibitors who do not follow the rules may be ejected at any time without recompense at the discretion of the Festival Organizers.

Cancellations received 7 days or more prior to the event will receive a refund minus a \$25 administration fee. Cancellations received less than 7 days prior to the event will not be refunded.
