







# Upcoming Town-wide Inventory Projects

- ADA Accessibility Inventory
  - Make prioritized ADA improvements to sidewalks and crosswalks

- Road/Lane Width Inventory
  - Reduce lane widths and increase paved shoulder widths, where feasible



### Trail Projects

- Build "Enhanced Accessibility"/ADA Trails
- Obtain Trail Licenses/Easements (LMAC)
- Finish Incomplete Subdivision Trails
- Look for Trail-Sidewalk Linkage & Regional Trail Opportunities
