Many of our programs are adversely affected every year due to participants waiting until the last minute to register. Refunds...

If **FCP** cancels/changes a course, we will refund or credit 100% of class fees. **On-line conven***ience fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.*

A processing fee ranging from \$5.00-\$10.00 will be charged for each course from which **you withdraw no less than five full business days prior to the start of the program unless otherwise noted. After this time, you <u>may</u> receive a 50% refund if a replacement can be found (waiting list has priority), the withdrawal does not affect course minimum enrollment, there is unlimited enrollment or the set date of withdrawal has not passed.

We reserve the right to credit your account for all refunds under \$10.00. If requesting a check for a larger refund, please allow a minimum of two weeks for processing.

WE DO NOT GIVE REFUNDS AFTER THE START OF THE SECOND CLASS.




Youth Pick-Up Policy
